

Luminaire Safety Instruction 88935/88936

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION, PLEASE READ BEFORE OPERATING LAMP.

DO NOT DESCARD. KEEP FOR REFERENCE.

Note: The Important safeguards and instruction appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur, It must be understood that common sense, caution and care are factors that cannot be built into any product. These factors must be supplied by the person(s) assembling this unit.

NOTE: WHEN ASSEMBLING THE LAMP, EXERCISE CAUTION AS TO NOT CRIMP/EXPOSE BARE WIRE OF THE LAMP. DO NOT PULL THE WIRE EXCESSIVELY DURING ASSEMBLING AS IT MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO CONNECTIONS.

Carefully unpack all package materials and set the lamp on the ground. Preferably on a soft surface.

* LIGHT BULB CAN BE VERY HOT FROM NORMAL USE!

WARNING: *TO REDUCE THS RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY, FOLLOW THE LISTED INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Allow $\it sufficient$ time for spent 15 minutes light bulb to COOL before attempting to remove it.
- 2. Always UNPLUG the lamp before replacing light bulb, using a soft cloth in handling light bulb when replacing is recommended.
- 3. Operate the lamp with 1xMax.230W/220-240V~ /R7s & 1xMax.40W /220-240V~/G9 type bulbs.
- 4. When the lamp is turned on with the light bulb lit, DO NOT touch the light bulb at any time.
- 5. The min. distance of lighted object is 0.5m
- 6. To change the lamp bulb, please unplug the mains.
- 7. Do not touch the lampshade/bulb surroundings /glass shield during use, They are HOT.
- 8. The lamp can only be used in dry room.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.





Assembly Instruction

Please pay attention to the following instruction when you assemble the lamp 1. After you take the lamp out of the package, please lay the lamp parts on a

- 2. Remove the pole end cable protectors before assembly
- 3. Please lock the upper poles to the lamp shade, and take care that the cord not be damaged
- 4. Please screw the lower pole on the bolt, and take care that the power cord not be damaged
- 5. Then please fix the one pole onto the base plate with the disjunctive part, wand the nuts tightly.
- 6. Please screw the handle to fix the lampshade of son.
- 7. The luminaire operates at mains voltage and should be switched off before changing.
